Free schools meals

There are two schemes for free school meals:

- universal infant free school meals for all children in reception year, year 1 and year 2 – you don't need to apply as they're automatically given at the school
- free school meals for people on qualifying benefits
 you'll need to apply for these

If you claim qualifying benefits and your child is entitled to universal infant school meals, you should still apply for free school meals:

- Entitled to free events under the North Somerset Council HAF scheme (see info. overleaf)
- you will be entitled to half price school trips
- the school can receive funding for the free school meals
- Further information can be found here

Please note that if you are already in receipt of income related free school meals, please do not reapply as you may lose your entitlement.




