Medicines:

If your child is on any regular medication, please complete a "Permission to Administer Medication" form and return to school no later than Friday 16th May. If you are able to provide school with the medication by this date too that would be really helpful please. If the medication cannot be handed in before the day of the trip (eg, antibiotics) please hand to Mrs Parker on the Wednesday morning. Label the bottle/packet clearly with your child's name and dosage. If you want to talk through the form with Mrs Parker beforehand, please let us know. Your child **must not** carry any medicines (except an inhaler) in their bags. Let Mr Farmer and Mrs Parker know if your child has a Ventolin Inhaler. This should not be handed to staff as your child must be responsible for his/her own inhaler and have it with them at all times. However, a spare inhaler must be given to Mrs Parker for safe keeping.

Arrangements for 1st day:

On Wednesday 21st May please arrive at 8:15am as we will leave school at 8:30am, the coach journey will be approximately 1½ hours. If your child suffers from travel sickness, please ensure that they have taken something to prevent this on the outward journey. (It would also be useful if Mrs Parker has a dose for the return journey). The children should have all their kit packed in a soft sports bag or a suitcase that they can carry themselves. They should wear comfortable clothes and will be able to change for their 1st activity when they arrive at Ultimate Adventure.









In their day bag/rucksack which they keep with them they should have:

- Packed lunch and drink with a drinks bottle which they will use each day. (No glass bottles
 or cans please).
- Children entitled to free school meal will be provided with a free packed lunch.
- Ventolin inhaler if needed.
- Entertainment for the coach pencil and paper, book to read, travel games, cards etc. No chewing gum, but they may bring a small amount of sweets and non- messy snacks to eat while at camp. Please ensure that all food is nut free.

Kit list

See separate sheet. Labels where relevant will help your child look after their belongings. The children should be able to carry their own bag. Please make sure that the children have two pairs of comfortable shoes to wear in addition to a pair of shoes that will get wet – see kit list for details. The children should be equipped with a **waterproof** (not showerproof) cagoule for wet weather as activities will carry on in the rain and it will be cold if they get wet. Also to remember their swimsuit, two towels, sun cream and hat if appropriate.
