SEND update for Reception to Year 6

All children who are on our SEND register also have an individual support plan (ISP) which outlines their need, provide outcomes and identifies specific details around the support in place for them in school. If your child joined us in September 2025 into our Reception classes, and was identified on the SEND register in their previous setting or has subsequently been identified and added to the SEND register, we will be working to create these plans over this term, following term 1 transition. If your child has an education health care plan (EHCP) issued by North Somerset, the ISP will include the provision that has been agreed from the EHCP.

Later this term, all families of children on the SEND register will be offered a meeting with the class teacher to go through the ISP, review it and discuss next steps that have been identified for your child for the remainder of the academic year. You will also be given a chance to add your parent voice to the ISP. Class teachers will be in touch with you to arrange a suitable time to meet. Please note, these meetings are offered in addition to our parents evenings. You will also be given a copy of your child's individual support plan (ISP). ISP review meetings take place three times a year in Term 2, 4 and 6. Again, these are in addition to EHCP annual reviews which take place yearly.
