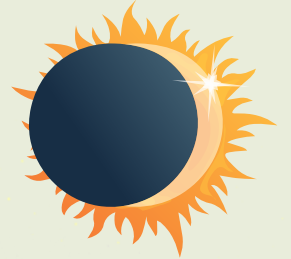

Science Week



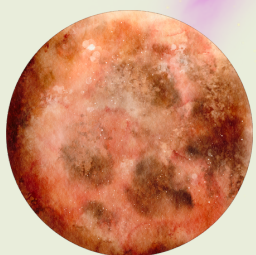
For the final day of Science Week this afternoon we have had 4 workshops around the school that the children have experienced in their house teams.

Below are some of the ways that you can argue in a helpful way:

- Active Listening
- Offering solutions
- Be open-minded to suggestions
- Agreeing to disagree
- Explain how you feel
- Make specific time for difficult conversations
