





Life Cycle - Bikeability level 2 parental consent form

We are delighted to be able to offer our pupils Bikeability level 2, on-road cycle training. The course is funded by North Somerset Council and the Department for Transport and delivered by Life Cycle. Places are limited and will be allocated on a **first come first served** basis. Your child will need a roadworthy cycle to take part. After an initial assessment of their riding skills on the first session, they will be riding on-road, with qualified instructors and **must** be able to cycle already, it is **not** a beginners course.

Please make sure your child comes to school with

- Roadworthy cycle with two working brakes See safety check details below.
- Helmet
- Weather appropriate clothing (raincoat, gloves, sunscreen etc.)
- Water bottle
- Lock cycles are to <u>be locked</u> in the bike shed on arrival at school.
