A big thank you to all who entered a cake into the Bake Off competition yesterday. What talented bakers we have here at Banwell!



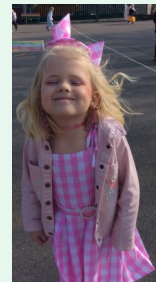
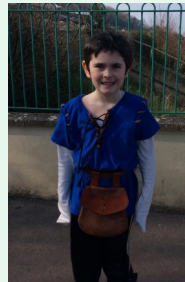
Well done to Florence & Elise for their winning entry of 'Oi Frog!' Our judge though it was fantastic.
