The holidays, activities and food programme (HAF) is an initiative run by the government to provide sessions during school holidays for children who are in receipt of income related free school meals. Each session runs for a minimum of 4 hours and children will be provided with a meal at no cost to parents. Further detailed information can be found <u>here.</u>

Are you entitled?

All reception –Year 2 age pupils are entitled to universal infant free school meals. But you may also be entitled to income related free school meals. Which you would receive When your child gets to Year 3 you will need to pay for their school meals, £2.55 per day unless you qualify for free school meals.

Qualifying benefits for free school meals

Your child will be entitled to free school meals if you get any of these benefits:

- income support
- income-based Jobseeker's Allowance (JSA)
- income-related Employment and Support Allowance (ESA)
- support under Part VI of the Immigration and Asylum Act 1999
- · the guaranteed element of Pension Credit
- Child Tax Credit (provided you're not also entitled to Working Tax Credit and have an annual gross income of no more than £16,190)
- Working Tax Credit run-on, paid for four weeks after you stop qualifying for Working Tax Credit
- Universal Credit with annual take home pay/met earnings below £7,400 (which equals £616.67 per month) benefits not included

In order to find out, please register the North Somerset citizens portal. This is a simple and easy application process. <u>https://ems.n-somerset.gov.uk/CCSCitizenPortal_LIVE/en</u>

If you are eligible for free school meals you can also qualify for:

- Free holiday club provision HAF
- Household support fund vouchers The last voucher released was £60 per child, per family eligible for free school meals.

The school also receives funding for every child in receipt of free school meals which goes towards providing subsidies for school trips, quality curriculum provision and interventions staffing as well as much more.

Thanks also go to Claire Spencer (Treasurer), resigning from the committee but continuing to support us in the 'friend of friends' group.


Rebecca Summers (Secretary) also resigned her position earlier in the year. Thank you for all the work you did during your time in the role.
