He will be teaching the children some fun tennis skills! 🎾

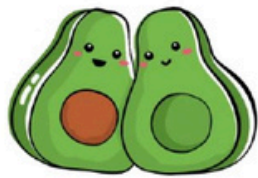

A big well done to all who took part – you represented us wonderfully! 🙌❤️



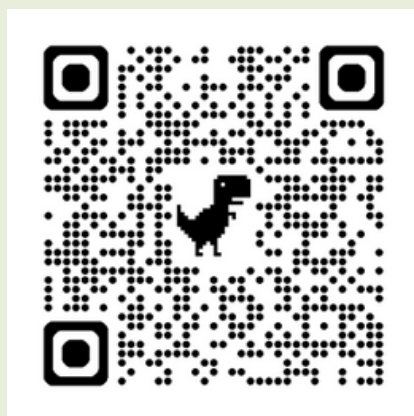

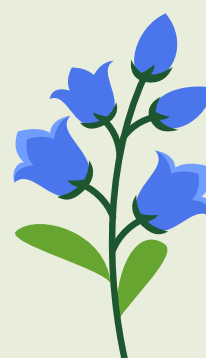

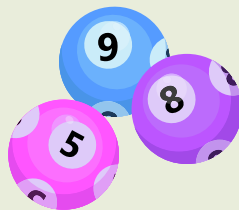
### PTA Committee Roles
